Dear Parents:

Thank you for your prayers and support! Winter weather is upon us, if you did not receive a message on your phone that school was cancelled, please stop by the office and let us know. We ask that you remember to bring coats and hats with their name in them, we have had several students without coats or only light jackets. If your child is running a fever, has diarrhea, or is vomiting, they must be free of these symptoms for 24 hours before they can return to school.
